

VICTORIAN VILLAGE: THE PARK LODGE

You will need

- park-lodge.pdf (.pdf)
- A colour or black and white printer
- A piece of A4 card and/or piece of A4 paper
- PVA glue or glue stick
- Scissors
- Stanley knife
- Coloured pencils or felt tip pens
- An adult to help

What to do

1. Print The Park Lodge on to an A4 piece of card using a colour or black and white printer. If you cannot print on to card, print on to A4 paper and use glue to stick the paper to card.
2. If you have printed The Park Lodge in black and white, you may want to colour it in.
3. Use scissors to cut out The Park Lodge carefully. Make sure you cut around the tabs along the side of the building. You may need an adult to help you here.
4. Fold along the black lines shown.
5. Put glue on the tabs and press them firmly to each of the walls. Now you should be able to stand up The Park Lodge.
6. Fold the roof along the line in the middle. Place the roof on top of the building. Then stick the tabs to the inside of the walls firmly.
7. To make your lady and gentleman, horsemen and horse and cart stand up, mark small slits (using the Stanley knife) on the rectangular strip (the base they stand on) about 3mm from the top and 2mm from the bottom (the lines are marked). Make sure you don't cut the base in to pieces! Then take a piece of card about the same length as the base, and cut it to a width slightly less than the slit you've already made. Now you can slot the new strip of card into the

marked slit in the rectangular base to make a cross shape. This will ensure they are less likely to fall over!
