

VICTORIAN VILLAGE: THE BARN

You will need

the-barn.pdf

A colour or black and white printer

PVA glue or a glue stick

A4 piece of thin card and/or A4 paper

Scissors

Stanley knife

Coloured pencils or felt tips

An adult to help

What to do

1. Print on to an A4 piece of card using a colour or black and white printer. If you cannot print straight on to card, print on to A4 paper and use glue to stick the paper to the card.
2. If you have printed The Barn in black and white, you may want to colour it in.
3. Use scissors to cut out each part of The Barn carefully, including the farm workers, haystacks, hay wagon and nanny goat. Make sure you cut around the tabs along the side of the building. You may need an adult to help you here.
4. Ask an adult to help you mark the slits (shown as black lines) for the tabs to insert into, using a Stanley knife. There are four slits on the roof and four on the side of The Barn.
5. Fold The Barn along the black lines firmly. Fold the roof along the line in the middle.
6. Push the tabs through the slits you have marked to join the walls together. You should now be able to stand The Barn up.
7. Push the tabs on the top of the walls through the marked slits in the roof. The Barn is now complete!

8. To make your people stand up, mark a small slit (using the Stanley knife) on the rectangular strip (the base the people stand on) about 3mm from the top and 2mm from the bottom. Then take a piece of card about the same length as the base, and cut it to a width slightly less than the slit you've already made. Now you can slot the new strip of card into the marked slit in the base to make a cross shape. This will ensure your people are less likely to fall over! Do the same with the haystacks, the hay wagon and nanny goat.
